







Amasra -Safranbolu-Kastamonu Tour:

Day 1)

Leave Ankara 07.30. Drive to the Black Sea Coast of Turkey. It is about a 4 hour drive. Reach Amasra in the noon time. Have lunch in a traditional fish restaurant on the coast of the town. Amasra's fish and salads are really delicious, fresh and famous...Visit Amasra's Castle, archaeology museum, the big port and the small port, the traditional streets and the wood market. Overnight at Amasra in a local hotel.

Day 2)

Drive to the town of Safranbolu. Famous for saffron production and Turkish Delights and Bazaars.. The Old Town preserves many historic buildings, with 1008 registered historical artifacts. These are: 1 private museum, 25 mosques, 5 tombs, 8 historical fountains, 5 Turkish baths, 3 caravanserais, 1 historical clock tower, 1 sundial and hundreds of houses and mansions. Safranbolu was added to the list of UNESCO World Heritage sites in 1994 due to its well-preserved Ottoman era houses and architecture. Overnight at Safranbolu in a traditional hotel.

Day 3)

After the breakfast depart from the Safranbolu hotel. Drive to the city of Kastamonu. Visit the Kastamonu Archaeological Museum, the Traditional Government Building of the city, the statue of Şerife Bacı (national female war hero of the town). Drive up to the Kastamonu Castle. Lunch in a traditional restaurant. Drive back to Ankara. Arrive at Ankara around 08.00 pm. End of the tour.
