



Konya-Butterfly Museum-Çatalhöyük Tour:

Day 1) Leave Ankara at 07:30. Drive to Konya in Central Turkey. Around 3-4 hour drive. Visit the tomb of Mevlana, considered as the founder of Sufism. He was a religious Muslim leader who lived in the 13th Century. Visit his tomb and the museum. Have lunch in a traditional restaurant. Drive to the Konya Butterfly Museum. (<http://www.konyakelebeklervadisi.com/>) One of the biggest Butterfly museums where the tropical butterflies fly in a special domed tropical garden and the visitors enjoy watching them and walk around them. Watch the Whirling Dervishes Show which is held on every Saturday in the Mevlana Culture Center. (Due to Covid, this could be cancelled). Overnight in Konya.

Day 2) After the breakfast at the hotel, visit the Konya Karatay Seljuk Tiles Museum and drive to the archaeological site of Çatalhöyük where the dead bodies were buried under the houses of the ancient people. See the excavation site, visit the replica houses of 8000 years ago, visit the information center, and return Ankara. Reach home around 08:00 pm.

Tour includes: All transportation from Ankara (US Embassy Building) to Konya, English Guidance, Parking Fees and Fuel. Overnight at a local hotel. Breakfast on 2nd Day morning at the hotel.

Tour excludes: Lunch, Dinner, Entrance Fees to the Sites, personal expenses, tips to the guide and the driver.
